## **CALLING FOR VOLUNTEERS AT THE CARE CENTER**

This will be a big help to encourage our residents.

We will be happy to provide further details and answer questions. This is a great way to serve. We have 6 small dining rooms in Assisted Living and would like to have 2 people in each dining room (total of 12 volunteers each day.) We will do this 2 days per week to start (24 volunteers), but hope it will expand to 5 or more days per week with sufficient response. This is a wonderful way to be a model of Christ's love for them, while just being a part of their life for a short time each week.
