### **Names in Scripture For Jesus**

Words enable us to express thoughts and ideas. Our Heavenly Father graciously gave us His Holy Word to reveal His plan for mankind and express His love for us through the advent of His Son, Jesus. In the Bible, both the Old and New Testaments, there are dozens of names used to describe Jesus Christ. Each of these names describes an attribute of Jesus and gives us a deeper understanding of His nature. Let's look at just a few of them:

**Christ** (Matt. 16:16) - from the Greek, means "anointed one". To anoint someone indicates a person's appointment to a special task. Jesus was God's Anointed, sent to save man from his sin.

**Messiah** (Daniel 9:25) - from the Hebrew, also means "anointed one".

**Immanuel** (Isaiah 7:14) - Hebrew, means "God with us". Jesus, when he was born of the virgin Mary, became God in the flesh and dwelt among us.

**Lamb of God** (John 1:29) - Only an unblemished lamb was an acceptable sacrifice in the Old Testament. Jesus was the perfect, unblemished Lamb sacrificed for our sins.

**Good Shepherd** (John 10:11) - A good shepherd cares deeply for his sheep and is even willing to risk his life protecting them. Jesus loves us, His sheep, so much He died to protect us from the consequences of our sins.

**Bread of Life** (John 6:35) - Bread was an essential food in ancient times. Jesus is essential to our eternal life.

**Advocate** (1 John 2:1) - A comforter; one who takes our side and pleads our case. Jesus is on our side and speaks on our behalf to the Father.

**Alpha and Omega** (Rev. 21:6) - The first and last letters of the Greek alphabet. Jesus is the beginning and end of all things. He created the world at the beginning of time, and He will judge mankind at the end of time.
