HELPERS NEEDED

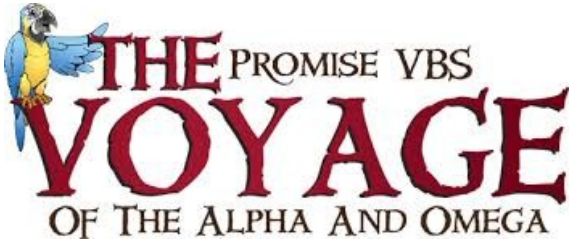

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Last week there was a postcard mailing to **2,500 households** in Eastpointe in close proximity to the church building, targeting the age groups for VBS. Also, this week an ad will be placed in the Eastpointe/Roseville Sentinel publication. The newspaper publication reaches over **30,000**. Another outreach opportunity takes place on **Saturday, June 18**. Northeast will have a booth/table along the route of the **Gratiot Cruise**. Our spot is in the parking lot of Cloverleaf Pizza. Volunteers are needed to pass out bags containing information about our congregation and invitations to VBS. These occasions have the potential to bring new families to our congregation. Keep these efforts in your prayers, that God will be glorified and that many will be able to learn of the hope that is within us.
