**Mark Wilson** is the chairman of the elders through June. You can contact him if you have any questions or concerns.

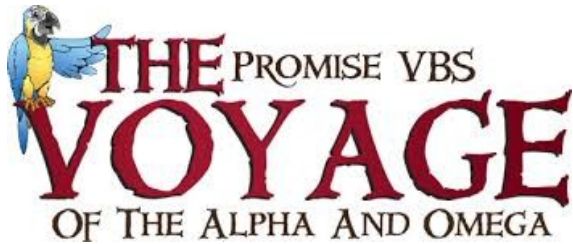
