



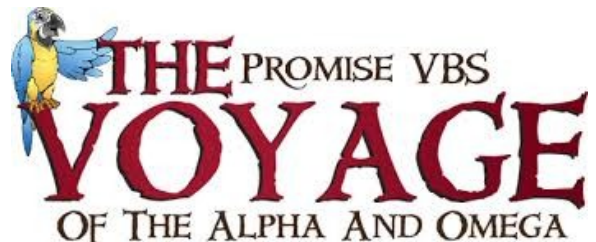

“This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth” (1 Timothy 2:3–4)

We can do no better than to preach Jesus and Him crucified to every soul in every place who will hear.
