In 1947, Elmer and Deborah Lewis donated 500 acres of farmland just south of Valparaiso, Indiana, for the purpose of providing Christian care for children in need. Since the first kids in 1956, over fifteen hundred children have been served at Shults-Lewis. Today, there are 7 separate residential homes which can support up to 56 kids, ages 12-18. They live with full-time, live-in house parents whose goal is to live and act in such a way that children see a non-smoking, non-drinking husband and wife team grounded in Christian principles and values.





The 27 employees of Shults-Lewis are required to be faithful members of the Church of Christ. They offer a wide variety of counseling services and operate their own private Christian school accredited by the state of Indiana. Along with 4 teachers, the school provides a year-round, comprehensive facility complete with a gymnasium, science lab and library. The organization remains committed to carrying forward a tradition of excellence in Christian child and family care and in showing Christ to troubled teens.

As fellow Christians, we are proud to help Shults-Lewis support these kids with the guidance and love they need. As we know from Proverbs 22:6, "Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it." We share some of our monetary blessings to fund this wonderful work on an annual basis in our budget, as well as through weekly milk money collections. Local mission outreach is a critical part of our faith, and we gladly continue to proclaim the kingdom of God.
