The Bible. We Want Everyone To Get It.

Eastern European Mission began in 1961 when seven young couples from Abilene Christian College were inspired to make it their purpose to help God's word overcome communism's oppression. Bibles were practically non-existent behind the Iron Curtain. Sometimes only one small hand-written portion was available for a whole village. EEM set out to find many ways to reach lost souls who had never heard the Good News.



EEM's mission is providing Bibles to the people of Eastern Europe in their own language. Initially, they smuggled and distributed limited quantities of Bibles, but after the wall fell in 1989, American Christians rushed to preach throughout Eastern Europe. In addition to churches, EEM started placing Bibles in schools, libraries, orphanages, hospitals and prisons – free to all men, women, and children. Currently, EEM works in over 20 countries and supplies material in 18 languages. As of 2015, EEM had placed Bibles

in Russia, Ukraine, Romania and Croatia, reaching more than 3,500,000 students in nearly 16,000 schools. Amazingly, at a time when the United States has removed the Bible from public education, EEM has succeeded in making it a critical part of many countries' curriculum.

Just as Paul explained to the church in Corinth, "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow" (1 Corinthians 3:6-7), we must help spread the Gospel. Northeast purposes a portion of our annual budget and also participates in "Million Dollar Sunday" to support EEM's work. For \$50, EEM is able to supply Bibles to 10 students, \$150 supplies for a class, and \$1,000 supplies an entire school with Bibles.
