HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). If you would like to further study this question of "What must I do to be saved?", please see our minister or one of our elders.

"... And his mother's name was Abi the daughter of Zechariah" (2 Kings 18:2)



As one reads through the histories of Israel and Judah after the division of the kingdom, one notices the tendency of the chronicler to name the mother of the king under discussion, not the father. Sometimes, as in the case of Hezekiah above, it became an accrual of honor because of the honorable life of the son.

More often, it was a notation of dishonor to the mother because so many of those kings were faithless.

Having noted this characteristic of the Bible record, it occurs to me that this suggests the most excellent gift that a child can bestow in honor of their mother. Many spent this past week trying to find some bauble that, admittedly, is inadequate to express appreciation and love to mother on Mother's Day. The television advertisements suggest that a properly grateful child will expend large sums of money and get mother a new cable-ready television with stereo. After all, isn't she worth it? (One would be insane to argue against that.) Most will be more practical and settle on some token of their esteem that is more in keeping with their budget while still conveying the idea of appreciation. But I would estimate that two or three years from now, our mothers won't remember the gift that was purchased for them this year.

So, while not discouraging your purchases, may I suggest a gift that will truly keep on giving - a son or daughter who lives a life of faithful adherence to the precepts of God's laws. Mothers are truly honored by such lives because the influence of motherhood is universally recognized as a primary force in the development of young lives. Great men and women of history have credited their mothers for their achievements. It cannot be denied. If a child really wishes to honor mother, it should be done with an honorable life.
