BRIAN'S TRIP TO INDIA

I would first like to thank each and every member of Northeast for the privilege to go minister with our Indian brothers for a brief amount of time. I will be flying out from Metro Detroit at 8:30 pm this coming Wednesday and will be arriving in Chennai, India 5:30 in the morning on Friday, where I will meet Brother Royce Frederick. While in Chennai, we will attend the Madarapakkam Preacher's Meeting where both Brother Frederick and I will have opportunities to speak. Sunday morning, the 21st, I will be attending worship with our brothers and sisters in Madarapakkam.

Monday morning, Brother Frederick and I will be attending and ministering at the National Bible College. Tuesday morning, we will fly from Chennai to Rajahmundry where I will be working with the Flemings until Saturday. The Flemings have works in several locations that I will be traveling to and assisting in whatever ways needed. Sunday, the 28th, I will be traveling with Brother D. Israel Raju as we minister at each of the five congregations he works with.



Monday afternoon, Brother Frederick and I will be working at the Kondapalli-Grace Tailoring School. That night I will be meeting and spending time with Brother D. Roberts in Vijayawada. Tuesday afternoon, I will fly from Vijayawada to Hyderabad where I will begin my international flight home Wednesday morning and will arrive back in Michigan late Wednesday night.

One of my professors who has been to India on many occasions wrote to me saying: "It will change your life if you have never been in the 3rd world before. You will never be the same again. You will fall in love with these people. It is easy to baptize them, because 'washing' for purification is built into their culture for thousands of years. Tell them about how God is good and about how Jesus was perfect and sinless and our Savior. You will find that they are very spiritual. . . You will feel sorrow AND joy after this trip for the rest of your life."

I am very excited to take this trip to India, and as much as I am preparing to preach and teach and minister to the people in whatever ways I can, I believe that I will be the one ministered to in unfathomable ways.
