LECTURESHIPS

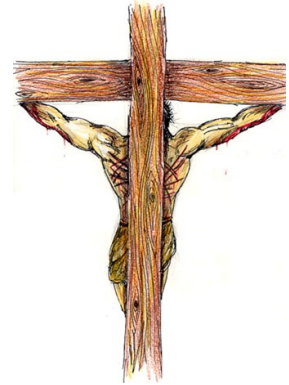
